

NOTICE OF NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF CHAPTER 282 OFFICERS

In accordance with Part IV of the National Treasury Employees Union (NTEU) Bylaws and pursuant to a voluntary compliance agreement entered into by NTEU and the U.S. Department of Labor, Office of Labor-Management Standards (OLMS), nominations and an election for the offices of president, executive vice president, treasurer, secretary, chief steward, CBER vice president, CDER vice president (2), CDRH vice president, CFSAN vice president, CVM vice president, OC vice president, ORA/BTL district vice president, and CTP vice president are being conducted under OLMS supervision. These positions will be elected in accordance with the standards of conduct provisions of the Civil Service Reform Act of 1978, and provisions of the Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959 (LMRDA) that have been made applicable to elections of officers in federal sector employee unions by 29 CFR 458.29, and the NTEU National Constitution and the Chapter 282 Constitution and By-laws, insofar as lawful and practicable.

The term of office will begin shortly after the ballot tally and will end on April 30, 2025. The elected president and executive vice president will also serve as ex-officio delegates to the NTEU national convention.

For this election only, nominations for president, executive vice president, treasurer, secretary, chief steward, CBER vice president, CDER vice president (2), CDRH vice president, CFSAN vice president, CVM vice president, OC vice president, ORA/BTL district vice president, and CTP vice president must be submitted in writing to OLMS Election Supervisor Mark Coldren via e-mail at nteu282election@dol.gov or via U.S. mail at NTEU Chapter 282, Election Supervisor, P.O. Box 77651, Washington, DC 20013. The nomination form attached to this notice should be used to make nominations. All nominations should include the nominee's name, telephone number, e-mail address, and the position they are being nominated for as well as the nominator's name, telephone number, and e-mail address. Nominations must be **received** no later than **November 10, 2022** to be valid. Self-nominations are permitted and seconds are not required. Members may only nominate one person for each office other than CDER vice president where two nominations are permitted.

Any member in good standing of Chapter 282 is eligible to nominate a candidate for Chapter 282 office. Members who are considered supervisors under the Federal Service Labor Management Relations Statute are not eligible to nominate candidates or run for office. A member must be in continuous good standing for the 24 months prior to October 24, 2022 and not be an officer of another union representing federal employees in order to run for office.

The OLMS election supervisor will notify all nominees of their nomination in writing. Each nominee must accept their nomination in writing to the OLMS election supervisor at nteu282election@dol.gov. Members may only run for **one** office. If nominated for multiple offices, the nominee must choose which office they want to run for.

The election will be conducted by mail ballot. Ballots will be mailed to all members at their last known home address in mid to late November 2022. Additional information regarding the election will be provided in a separate notice which will be mailed to all Chapter 282 members at a later date and posted on the Chapter 282 website.
