

# 2009 POWER Program

The goal of the 2009 POWER Program is to strengthen chapter legislative and political programs and to engage chapters in grassroots activity throughout the year.

Attached is a copy of the reporting form to be used by your chapter for participation in NTEU's POWER Program, which recognizes achievement in legislative and political activities. NTEU urges all chapters to participate in the POWER Program, as your reporting forms provide valuable information, which NTEU's legislation department can use in pursuit of pro-federal employee policy on Capitol Hill. **NTEU needs your report to get information on what is taking place in your locale. It is critically important that you participate.**

Please note that the structure for the 2009 POWER Reporting form has changed. NTEU has revamped its' POWER program to engage NTEU membership on a broader scale. With a new Congress and Administration, NTEU's voice must be carried far and wide to impact Congress in a practical and effective manner.

## Comprehensive Reporting Periods:

January 1, 2009 – June 30, 2009 → File report by August 1, 2009

July 1, 2009 – December 31, 2009 → File report by January 9, 2010

- All chapters that file POWER Reports for **both reporting periods earn an invitation to a special event** with the National President during the legislative conference to discuss legislative and political issues;
- All Chapters participating in POWER receive an NTEU certificate of recognition;
- POWER participants that have had exceptional progress with their members of congress on NTEU legislative issues, conducted increased off-site activities, and have at least 10% of membership participating in TEPAC will be obtain special recognition which may include:
  1. NTEU POWER plaques for the Chapter.
  2. Chapter recognition in an NTEU publication.
  3. Chapter recognition at National Trainings Conferences.
