fought to help women have a fair chance at advancement and promotion in the federal workplace during her 44-year career at the Treasury Department.

In the early 1960s, Lawton wrote a report on discrimination against women in the department and in 1969, she was named Federal Woman of the Year. Lawton spent the next decade helping to develop lists of women qualified for supergrade positions. In 1972, she rose to Deputy Director of Personnel, then the highest ranking woman in the Treasury Department.
